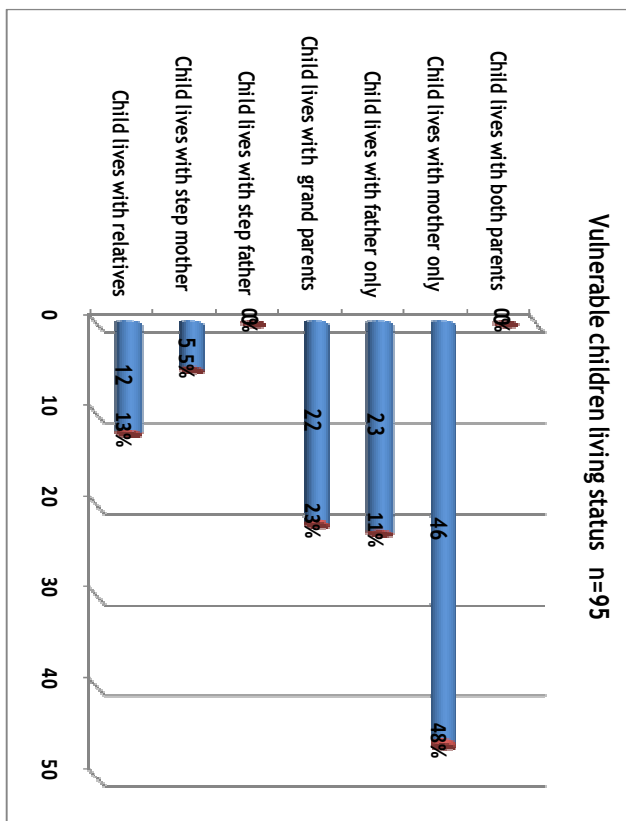


What the survey in 2019! Vulnerable children needs assessment study conducted in Nzuguni, Ihumwa and Mtumba

wards at rural areas, Dodoma city rural areas
The study aimed to measure children vulnerability status in the wards communities to scale up projects for their welfare.

The survey sampled 95 vulnerable children (Pupils) , 6primary school teachers and 5guardians/parents to abstain major erroneous findings.

With the use of Lots of Quality Assurance Sampling analysis tool (LQAS analysis tool) and Microsoft Excel (Ms Excel), the sample size (106 people) was calculated by the stratified Sampling Technique. Herewith are the displayed some parts of the whole assessment.



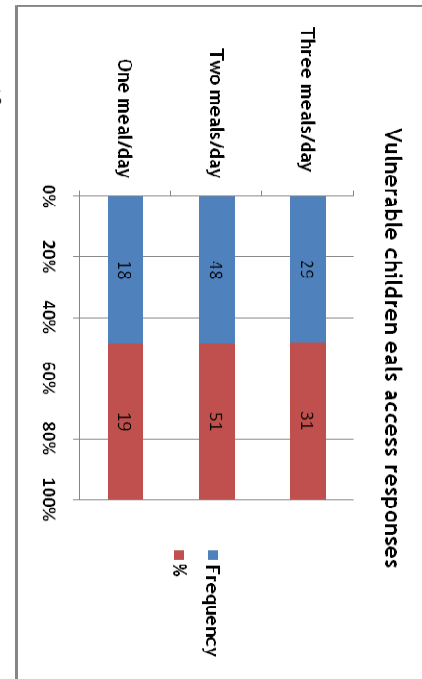

As per above children vulnerability finding, Out of 95 children, 48% (46) protrudes most examining children living with mother only caused by divorces, death and mostly fathers abandoned families and get married to another women. Indeed children being both poorly access human basic needs and nurtured.



Vision: To see all persons attaining best living standard ,wellness, justice and prosperity

The study tested children on Meals access and found the most two meals/day intake to 95(51%) is the highest in comparison with one or three meals intake per day affecting even their classes concentration
